<u>Proposed law</u> amends and reenacts Code of Criminal Procedure Articles 551(B), 553(A) and (C), 831, 832, 833(A) and (C), and 900(A)(introductory paragraph), (B), and (C) and enacts Code of Criminal Procedure Articles 556(E), 556.1(F), and 562, relative to presence of the defendant. It also adds for an incarcerated defendant's entry of a guilty plea and revocation hearings for a probation violation.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

The proposed legislation will likely result in an indeterminable decrease in SGF expenditures in the Department of Public Safety and Corrections - Correction Services if certain incarcerated defendants are authorized to appear in court by way of simultaneous audio-visual transmission. The department reports the proposed law will reduce the number of court trips for offenders to appear in court and any potential cost for equipment / technology incurred would be incidental. Proposed law is permissive, not mandatory, and will not require an expenditure to outfit individual unequipped courts to facilitate simultaneous audio-visual transmission.
