Abraham

Abstract: Prohibits dual-enrollment in the Firefighters' Retirement System (FRS) and enrollment in another La. retirement system for employees first covered by FRS.

<u>Present law</u> requires a person who is employed by more than one public employment and who is eligible for membership in a state or statewide retirement system as a condition of such employment to be a member of each such retirement system. <u>Proposed law</u> provides that <u>present law</u> does not apply to dual membership in FRS.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires that a covered employee simultaneously employed by more than one covered employer shall become a member of FRS as an employee of only one employer. <u>Proposed law</u> provides that if such an employee retires from one employment, any continued employment with a covered employer shall be governed by <u>present law</u> return-to-work provisions. <u>Proposed law</u> provides that a person who is a member of any other La. public retirement system when he becomes a covered-employee shall not become a member of FRS while he remains a member of the other retirement system. <u>Proposed law</u> further provides that limitations of FRS membership provided in <u>proposed law</u> do not make a person eligible for membership in any other public retirement system as otherwise required under present law.

Requires prospective and retroactive application of proposed law.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The Committee Amendments Proposed by House Committee on Retirement to the original bill:

1. Specify that the <u>proposed law</u> exception to the <u>present law</u> general rule regarding dual membership applies only to dual membership within FRS.
