- 9 On page 2, between lines 17 and 18, insert the following:

I. When a child is conceived as the result of a sex offense as defined in R.S.

15:541, the victim of the sex offense who is the custodial parent may petition to
terminate the rights of the perpetrator of the sex offense. Termination shall result in
the loss of custody, visitation, contact, and other parental rights of the perpetrator
regarding the child, but shall not affect the inheritance rights of the child. The
perpetrator shall be cast in judgment for court costs."
