**HEALTH CARE** Page 1 of 1 Provides for physician assistants executing emergency certificates relative to alleged mental illness or substance abuse.

Present law authorizes any physician, psychiatric mental health nurse practitioner, or psychologist to execute an emergency certificate after an examination of a person alleged to be mentally ill or suffering from substance abuse who is determined to be in need of immediate care and treatment in a treatment facility.

Proposed law expands this authority to physician assistants in collaboration with their supervising physician.
