REGISTRAR OF VOTERS RET. Provides for the treasurer and the secretary of state to be members of the board of trustees. $(6 / 30 / 17)$

AN ACT
To amend and reenact R.S. 11:2091(B), relative to the board of trustees for the Registrar of Voters Employees' Retirement System; to provide for membership of the board of trustees; to provide for an effective date; and to provide for related matters.

Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published.
Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: Section 1. R.S. 11:2091(B) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows: §2091. Board of trustees; membership; vacancies; compensation
B. The board shall consist of eight ten trustees as follows:
(1) A member of the House Committee on Retirement appointed by the speaker of the House of Representatives, or the member's designee.
(2) The chairman of the Senate Committee on Retirement, ex officio, or his designee.
(3) The secretary of state, ex officio, or his designee.
(4) The treasurer, ex officio, or his designee.
(5) Six active and contributing members of the system who shall have at least

ten years of creditable service in the Registrars of Voters Employees' Retirement System who shall be elected by the members of the Registrars of Voters Employees' Retirement System according to the rules and regulations adopted by the board of trustees to govern such elections. The term of office of the six elected board members shall be for a period of four years; provided, that one elected member whose term of office begins January 1, 2012, shall serve an initial term of two years, with subsequent terms of four years. No elected trustee may serve for more than two consecutive four-year terms, exclusive of any term being served on December 31, 2011. If an elected trustee elects to participate in the Deferred Retirement Option Plan after his term has commenced, he may continue to serve for the remainder of the term for which he was elected; however, if he otherwise separates from service, his term shall expire.

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(4) Notwithstanding the provisions of Paragraph (3) of this Subsection, the term of offiee for any person elected and serving on the board of trustees on Deeember 31, 2011, shall be extended to Deeember thinty-first of the year in whieh the term expires.
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Section 2. This Act shall become effective on June 30, 2017; if vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on June 30, 2017, or on the day following such approval by the legislature, whichever is later.

Present law provides for the membership of the board of trustees for the Registrar of Voters Employees' Retirement System (ROVERS):
(1) A member of the House Committee on Retirement appointed by the speaker of the House of Representatives, or the member's designee.
(2) The chairman of the Senate Committee on Retirement, ex officio, or his designee.
(3) Six active and contributing members of the system who shall have at least ten years of creditable service in the ROVERS who shall be elected by the members of ROVERS.

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Proposed law provides for two additional members, the secretary of state, ex officio, or his designee and the treasurer, ex officio, or his designee.
