HOUSE FLOOR AMENDMENTS

Amendments proposed by Representative Huval to Engrossed House Bill No. 468 by Representative Emerson

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, delete lines 2 through 6 in their entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following:

3 "To amend and reenact R.S. 37:562(A) and (B), 563(introductory paragraph), (1),
4 and (9) through (17), 575(A)(10), 581(A), 590(A)(1), 597, and 602, and to
5 enact R.S. 37:563(18) through (24), 582.1, 584(D), 589(C) and (D), and
6 591.2, relative to the Louisiana Cosmetology Act; to modify legislative
7 intent; to provide for definitions; to provide relative to powers and duties of
8 the board; to provide relative to unlawful practices; to provide with respect
9 to special permits and requirements relative to hair braiders, hair braiding
10 facilities, threaders, threading facilities, estheticians, and manicurists; to
11 provide for related permit fees; and to provide for related matters."

12 AMENDMENT NO. 2

13 On page 1, delete lines 8 through 10 in their entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following:

14 "Section 1. R.S. 37:562(A) and (B), 563(introductory paragraph), (1), and (9) through
15 (17), 575(A)(10), 581(A), 590(A)(1), 597, and 602 are hereby amended and reenacted and
16 R.S. 37:563(18) through (24), 582.1, 584(D), 589(C) and (D), and 591.2 are hereby enacted
17 to read as follows:"

18 AMENDMENT NO. 3

19 On page 1, between lines 10 and 11, insert the following:

20 "§562. Legislative findings; purpose; intent

21 A. The legislature finds that the practice of cosmetology, esthetics,
22 manicuring, hair braiding, and threading by qualified individuals is necessary to
23 protect the public health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the state of Louisiana.
24 The legislature further finds it to be a matter of public interest and concern that only
25 qualified persons be permitted to engage in the practice of cosmetology, esthetics,
26 manicuring, hair braiding, and threading.

27 B. The legislature hereby declares the purpose of this Chapter is to promote,
28 preserve, and protect the public health, safety, and welfare by and through the
29 effective control and regulation of the practice of cosmetology, esthetics,
30 manicuring, hair braiding, and threading.

32 AMENDMENT NO. 4

33 On page 1, delete lines 14 through 19 in their entirety

1 C. A hair braiding facility owner who is not a licensed cosmetologist or a
2 permitted hair braider shall employ one or more registered managers who shall be
3 licensed as cosmetologists or permitted as hair braiders. A registered manager shall
4 be present at the facility during all hours of operation and shall be responsible for
5 ensuring that all persons practicing hair braiding within the facility are appropriately
6 permitted and follow all applicable laws and rules and regulations. A hair braiding
7 facility owner who is absent from his respective facility more than two working days
8 per week shall employ a manager who shall be a registered cosmetologist or a
9 permitted hair braider and who shall obtain a certificate of registration as a manager.

10 D. A threading facility owner who is not a licensed cosmetologist,
11 esthetician, or permitted threader shall employ one or more registered managers who
12 shall be licensed as cosmetologists, estheticians, or permitted threaders. A registered
13 manager shall be present at the facility during all hours of operation and shall be
14 responsible for ensuring that all persons practicing threading within the facility are
15 appropriately licensed and follow all applicable laws and rules and regulations. A
16 threading facility owner who is absent from his respective facility more than two
17 working days per week shall employ a manager who shall be a registered
18 cosmetologist, esthetician, or permitted threader and who shall obtain a certificate
19 of registration as a manager.

20 §590. Renewal of certificates of registration

21 A.(1) Every beauty shop owner, mobile salon owner, booth renter, manager
22 of a beauty shop, hair braider, threader, hair braiding facility, threading facility,
23 manager of a braiding facility, manager of a threading facility, and school shall, on
24 or before January thirty-first of each calendar year, renew his or its certificate of
25 registration. Every certificate of registration which has not been timely renewed
26 shall expire on the following first day of March, at which time the holder of such
27 certificate of registration may have his certificate renewed only upon fulfilling the
28 requirements provided for by this Chapter and paying the restoration fee provided
29 in R.S. 37:599.

31 §591.2. Requirements for certification; hair braiding facility or threading facility

32 A. A person or entity shall not operate a hair braiding facility or threading
33 facility in this state without a permit issued by the board.

34 B. To obtain a permit as a hair braiding facility or threading facility, the
35 owner of such business shall do all of the following:

36 (1) Certify that all persons employed at such facility are appropriately
37 licensed or permitted to perform the services offered in the facility.

38 (2) Demonstrate that the required physical, sanitary, and administrative
39 facilities have been established.

40 (3) Submit an initial application for a new facility along with the appropriate
41 fee as specified in R.S. 37:599.

42 (4) Include the words "hair braiding facility" or "threading facility" in any
43 sign or advertisement for services.

44 C. A person licensed or permitted by the board shall not accept employment
45 or continue employment in a hair braiding facility or threading facility unless the
46 facility possesses a permit issued by the board.

47 D. A hair braiding facility or threading facility shall not offer or advertise
48 any cosmetology, esthetics, or manicuring services as defined in this Chapter unless
49 the facility obtains from the board the required licensure.
