SB 109 Reengrossed

2017 Regular Session

Claitor

Present law (R.S. 9:5821-5825) provides rules and exceptions for prescription by law and for legal extensions due to the hardships caused by Hurricanes Katrina and Rita.

Proposed law (R.S. 9:5826-5827) provides for the suspension or extension of peremption, prescription, and certain legal deadlines due to the hardships caused by the floods of 2016. Provides for the suspension or extension of prescriptive periods and preemptive periods for the period of time between Aug. 12, 2016, and Sept. 30, 2016.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The Committee Amendments Proposed by House Committee on Civil Law and Procedure to the reengrossed bill:

1. Replace all provisions of proposed law with provisions limited to specifying the purpose of proposed law and specifying the termination of the extension of the prescriptive and preemptive periods.
