| WHEREAS, LUMCON is transforming marine science in Louisiana by contributing                   |
| to science and conservation in meaningful and profound ways through leveraging of assets      |

| 4  | vessels along the Gulf of Mexico; with a long and distinguished career of service,               |
| 5  | LUMCON's marine operations are unmatched in the Gulf of Mexico and have gained respect           |
| 6  | from researchers and educators worldwide; and  |
| 7  | WHEREAS, the R/V Pelican is the flagship of LUMCON's research fleet and is                       |
| 8  | outfitted to conduct a variety of oceanographic research missions; the reliability, utility, and |
| 9  | seaworthiness of the vessel and the crew has been exhibited since 1985, and its effectiveness    |
| 10 | is heralded by the scientific community; often referred to by oceanographers as the              |
| 11 | "Workhouse of the Gulf", the R/V Pelican has a long track record of excellence in scientific     |
| 12 | research; and  |
| 13 | WHEREAS, LUMCON is committed to strengthening the marine science community                       |
| 14 | through education and outreach initiatives; and  |
| 15 | WHEREAS, LUMCON's education program purpose is to enable the development                         |
| 16 | of the next generation of marine scientists and ocean-literate citizens by providing             |
| 17 | meaningful and relevant place-based and skill-based experiences for all, while aiming to         |
| 18 | have significant impacts on Louisiana's diverse citizenry including those populations            |
| 19 | underrepresented and underserved in marine science; and  |
| 20 | WHEREAS, LUMCON is currently finalizing a strategic plan to guide the                            |
| 21 | organization to a position of greater service, science, and sustainability; and                  |
| 22 | WHEREAS, LUMCON stands strong on its values of the highest quality of education                  |
| 23 | programs, scientific inquiry, academic integrity, exchange of ideas and information,             |
| 24 | opportunities for students who are underrepresented in marine science, and increasing            |
| 25 | societal awareness of the environmental, economic, and cultural value of Louisiana's coast.      |
