Provides relative to the local match requirements for non-state entities applying for capital outlay funding.

The proposed law repeals the present law exception for non-state entity projects for which the non-state entity had demonstrated its inability to provide a local match. The proposed legislation authorizes the commissioner of administration to reduce the local match requirement for non-state entity projects to not less than 10% of the total project cost if the non-state entity executes a statement of sponsorship and an agreement to assume all maintenance and operation cost for the project(s). The proposed law is applicable to the funding of all non-state entity projects in the capital outlay bill beginning with FY 18.
