3 WHEREAS, anyone can join this campaign by pledging to wear orange on June 2  
4 to help raise awareness about gun violence; and

5 WHEREAS, by wearing orange on June 2, Americans will raise awareness about gun  
6 violence, and honor the lives and human potential of Americans stolen by gun violence; and

7 WHEREAS, it is desirable for citizens and public servants of the state of Louisiana  
8 to renew their commitment to reduce gun violence, to pledge to do all they can to keep  
9 firearms out of the wrong hands, and to encourage responsible gun ownership to help keep  
10 everyone safe.

11 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby  
12 recognize Friday, June 2, 2017, as National Gun Violence Awareness Day, and further  
13 encourages all citizens of the great state of Louisiana to support their communities' efforts  
14 to honor and value human lives by preventing the tragic effects of gun violence.
