I. SUMMARY OF JOINT RESOLUTION

This report is for House Bill No. <u>145</u> of the 2017 Regular Session by Representative <u>Garofalo</u>, proposing to amend Art. VII, Section 21(M)(1) of the Constitution.

HB 145 proposes to authorize a tax exemption for specific property owned by a surviving spouse of a person who dies while performing duties as an emergency medical responder, technician, law enforcement or fire protection officer, paramedic, or volunteer firefighter.

II. CONCLUSION

The proposed measure cannot be accomplished statutorily.

HB 145 proposes to authorize a tax exemption on certain properties. A constitutional amendment would be required to make this change in property tax exemptions.
