SUCCESSIONS: Provides relative to the release of certain account information for the estate of a decedent

Synopsis of Senate Amendments

1. Changes a term in <u>proposed law from</u>"decedent" <u>to</u> "estate" for the purpose of correcting a provision that requires satisfactory evidence of the relationship between a representative or attorney and the estate.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

<u>Proposed law</u> authorizes the disclosure of certain account information of a decedent by a dealer to a representative of, or attorney for, the decedent's estate upon sufficient proof of the death of the decedent and the relationship with the estate.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires that the dealer receive written notice of the customer's death and evidence of the person's authority to represent the estate.
