<u>Prior law</u> provided that the governor appoint members of the Louisiana State Board of Medical Examiners when a vacancy occurs for any reason including expiration of term, removal, resignation, death, disability, or disqualification in the same manner as the original appointment.

<u>Prior law</u> required that members of the board be appointed for a term of four years, beginning on July first in the year in which the appointment is made, unless the member is appointed to fill an unfinished term of his predecessor.

<u>New law</u> provides that no member shall serve more than three consecutive terms.

Effective upon signature of the governor (June 12, 2017).
