Amendments proposed by Senate Committee on Finance to Engrossed House Bill No. 403

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, delete "To amend and reenact R.S. 39:100.21, relative to special treasury
3 funds;" and insert "To provide relative to special treasury funds;"

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 1, line 3, delete "to provide for the"

6 AMENDMENT NO. 3

7 On page 1, line 4, delete "sources and uses of the Overcollections Fund;"

8 AMENDMENT NO. 4

9 On page 1, delete lines 13 through 18, and insert:

10 "Section 3. Notwithstanding any provision of the law to the contrary, the state
11 treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to transfer \$15,400,000 from the
12 Department of Revenue Escrow Account to the Overcollections Fund contingent
13 upon the enactment of Senate Bill No. 180 of the 2017 Regular Session of the
14 Louisiana Legislature.

15 Section 4. Notwithstanding any provision of the law to the contrary, the state
16 treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to transfer \$18,660,000 when the
17 Department of Revenue prevails in the suit, appeal, or petition associated with the
18 legislative instrument which originated as House Concurrent Resolution No. 8 of the
19 2015 Regular Session of the Louisiana Legislature and transfers the amount paid in
20 protest and held in escrow from the Department of Revenue to the Overcollections
21 Fund.

22 Section 5. Notwithstanding any provision of the law to the contrary, the
23 Department of Justice is hereby authorized and directed to transfer \$5,300,335 from
24 the escrow account to the state treasury, and the state treasurer is further authorized
25 and directed to transfer \$5,300,335 to the State Emergency Response Fund."

26 AMENDMENT NO. 5

27 On page 2, delete lines 1 through 11

28 AMENDMENT NO. 6

29 On page 2, delete lines 12 through 17 and insert:

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31 "Section 6. This Act shall take effect and become operative if and when the
32 Act which originated as Senate Bill No. 232 of this 2017 Regular Session of the
33 Legislature is enacted into law and becomes effective.

34 Section 7. Sections 1, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, and 8 of this Act shall become effective
35 upon signature of this Act by the governor, or, if not signed by the governor, upon
36 expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature by the governor, as
37 provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If vetoed by the
38 governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
39 effective on the day following such approval.

40 Section 8. Section 2 of this Act shall become effective on July 1, 2017."
