- B. The curriculum shall include at least five hundred hours of instruction that includes, but is not limited to, classes in bacteriology and sanitation, client consultation, hair types and hair structure, scalp diseases and disorders, shampoos, conditioners, herbal treatments and rinses, braiding
- and sculpting, and the Louisiana Cosmetology Act and rules and regulations.
- C. Nothing shall prevent or prohibit a local governing authority from
  levying an occupational tax on natural hair braiding services."
