

HOUSE SUMMARY OF SENATE AMENDMENTS

PROPERTY/PUBLIC: Authorizes the transfer of certain state property in Bossier Parish

Synopsis of Senate Amendments

1. Amend the property description to just that 55 acres, more or less, upon which the Northwest Support and Services Center is situated within Section 7.
2. Provides that a condition of the conveyance is that the state has the first right of refusal to purchase the property should the Arc of Acadiana decide to sell it.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

Authorizes the transfer or lease of 55 acres, more or less, upon which the Northwest Support and Services Center is situated within Section 7 in Bossier Parish from the Dept. of Health to the Arc of Acadiana. Provides for the reservation of mineral rights to the state. Provides that a condition of the conveyance shall be that the state has the first right of refusal to purchase the property should the Arc of Acadiana decide to sell it.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
