SUMMARY OF HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO THE RESOLUTION

- 1. Reduces membership of the task force by removing the following persons or their designees from the task force:
 - (a) the attorney general
 - (b) the state public defender
 - (c) the president of the La. District Attorney's Association
 - (d) a representative of the American Civil Liberties Union of La.
 - (e) a district court judge designated by the chief justice
 - (f) a representative of the La. State University Police Department.
 - (g) a representative of the Southern University Police Department.
 - (h) a representative of the National Association of the Advancement of Colored People.
 - (j) a mayor or city-parish president representing a suburban municipality as designated by the La. Municipal Association.
 - (k) the superintendent of Louisiana State Police
 - (l) the president of the Louisiana Association of Broadcasters
 - (m) the president of the Louisiana Press Association
 - (n) the president of the Senate
 - (o) the speaker of the House of Representatives
 - (p) a representative of the Louisiana Association of Criminal Defense Lawyers.
 - (q) the secretary of state
- 2. Adds the following members to the task force:
 - (a) the committee chairmen of the House judiciary and Senate Judiciary B
 - (b) two persons appointed by the president of the Senate
 - (c) two persons appointed by the speaker of the House of Representatives
