<u>Existing law</u> requires compliance with the existing minimum standards whenever a police employee or law enforcement officer is under investigation.

<u>Existing law</u> gives those employees and officers the right to obtain counsel and allows up to 30 days to secure such representation.

<u>New law</u> retains <u>existing law</u> but adds an exception for officer-involved incidents by granting law enforcement officers up to 14 days to secure representation for officer-involved incident investigations.

<u>New law</u> further provides that if the police employee or law enforcement officer is confined to a medical facility due to injury or illness related to the officer-involved incident, or if two or more officers are involved in the officer-involved incident, the police employees or law enforcement officers have 30 days to secure representation.

Effective August 1, 2017.
