ACT 135 (HB 120) 2017 Regular Session

Existing law provides for fees in civil matters to be paid to sheriffs as compensation.

New law retains existing law but increases the fees as follows:

- (1) Service and return of legal documents, notices, and subpoenas <u>from</u> \$20 to \$30.
- (2) Notice of seizure and sale and returns <u>from</u> \$20 to \$30 and return of any writ <u>from</u> \$20 to \$30.
- (3) Preparation for advertisement in newspapers <u>from</u> \$15 to \$30.
- (4) Execution for writ of possession or ejectment <u>from</u> \$20 to \$30.
- (5) Service of notice to vacate <u>from</u> \$20 <u>to</u> \$30.
- (6) Other actions to obtain possession of premises <u>from</u> \$20 to \$30.

<u>New law</u> makes these increases effective upon a recommendation by the Judicial Council in its 2018 report.
