<u>Existing law</u> requires new applicants for an agricultural consultant's certificate to furnish satisfactory evidence that they had earned at least four hours of college credit in each discipline area for which certification was sought.

 $\underline{\text{New law}}$ modifies $\underline{\text{existing law}}$ by reducing the amount of college credit $\underline{\text{from}}$ four hours $\underline{\text{to}}$ three hours.
