<u>New law</u> provides free parking for a disabled veteran, his conveyance, and his passengers at any air carrier airport.

<u>New law</u> requires the disabled veteran provide proof of disability in the form of a military honor license plate or a disabled veteran identification card.

<u>New law</u> specifies that the time period an authorized disabled veteran is granted free parking at airports cannot exceed 10 days. Further provides that a veteran may be charged the customary parking fee for each day he remains parked at the airport that exceeds 10 days.

<u>New law</u> authorizes each individual air carrier airport to determine its own procedures for validating parking vouchers or reimbursing a parking fee as provided in new law.

Effective August 1, 2017.
