Abstract: Prohibits the commissioner of conservation from regulating the hours a commercial facility may receive certain exploration and production waste.

<u>Present law</u> authorizes the commissioner of conservation to regulate the hours of operation of offsite treatment, storage and disposal facilities for exploration and production waste.

Proposed law prohibits such regulation of hours of operation.
