**Abstract:** Amends the elements of the crime of intentional exposure to the AIDS virus to apply to the intentional exposure to HIV.

<u>Present law</u> provides that no person shall intentionally expose another to any acquired immunodeficiency syndrome (AIDS) virus through any means or contact without the knowing and lawful consent of the victim.

<u>Proposed law</u> changes the elements <u>from</u> acquired immunodeficiency syndrome (AIDS) virus to the human immunodeficiency virus (HIV).

<u>Proposed law</u> amends the definition of "intentional exposure" to include a person who knows at the time of the exposure that he is HIV positive, has not disclosed his HIV-positive status, and acts with the specific intent to transmit HIV to the other person.

Proposed law provides affirmative defenses to the crime.
