Abstract: Changes the requirements for the Dept. of Public Safety to use in its determination of the qualifications and competence of individuals and laboratories who perform chemical analysis for the department.

<u>Present law</u> provides a list of accreditation bodies which the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections (department) may use to issue permits for the purposes of chemical analysis testing.

<u>Proposed law</u> modifies <u>present law</u> by removing the list of accreditation bodies and instead allows the department to use an individual or laboratory with an accreditation based upon the international standard, ISO/IEC 17025, for the purposes of chemical analysis testing.
