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POSTSECONDARY ED. Requires public school governing authorities to share certain student data with the Board of Regents. (gov sig)

AN ACT

2	To amend and reenact R.S. 17:3914(K)(2) and (3)(c)(i), relative to student information; to
3	require each public school governing authority to share certain student information
4	with the Board of Regents; to be used for limited purposes; to require the Board of
5	Regents to provide certain reports to each public school governing authority; and to
6	provide for related matters.
7	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
8	Section 1. R.S. 17:3914(K)(2) and (3)(c)(i) are hereby amended and reenacted to
9	read as follows:
10	§3914. Student information; privacy; legislative intent; definitions; prohibitions;
11	parental access; penalties

14	(2)(a) The governing authority of a public school shall disclose the
15	information collected pursuant to Paragraph (1) of this Subsection, upon request,
16	only to a:
17	(i) A Louisiana postsecondary educational institution, to be used solely for

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1	the purpose of processing applications for admission, and to the.
2	(ii) The Office of Student Financial Assistance, to be used solely for the
3	purpose of processing applications made to the office for state and federal grant and
4	for required grant program reporting.
5	(iii) The Louisiana Board of Regents, to be used solely for the purpose
6	of providing feedback reports to each public school governing authority on the
7	postsecondary remediation needs, retention rates, and graduation rates of
8	graduates from each high school under its jurisdiction, and to evaluate
9	comparative postsecondary performance outcomes based on certain student
10	characteristics in order to develop policies or make recommendations for
11	legislation to the legislature.

13	(3)(a) * * *
14	(c)(i) A statement notifying the student's parent or legal guardian exactly
15	what items of student information will be collected and that disclosure of the student
16	information collected will be restricted to Louisiana postsecondary educational
17	institutions and the Office of Student Financial Assistance to be used solely for the
18	purpose of processing applications for admission and for state and federal financial
19	aid and to the Board of Regents to be used solely for the purpose of providing
20	postsecondary feedback reports to the student's school governing authority or
21	in developing policies to help increase student success in postsecondary
22	education.

24	Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
25	signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
26	by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
27	vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become

effective on the day following such approval.

Appel

<u>Present law</u> provides that the governing authority of each public school, with the permission of a student's parent or legal guardian, shall collect specific student information.

<u>Present law</u> further provides that the governing authority of each public school shall disclose the information collected, upon request, to a public postsecondary institution or the Office of Student Financial Assistance.

<u>Proposed law</u> adds the Board of Regents to the entities that may request such information. Further provides that the Board of Regents may use the information only for the purpose of providing feedback reports to each public school governing authority on the postsecondary remediation needs, retention rates, and graduation rates of graduates from each high school under its jurisdiction, and to evaluate comparative postsecondary performance outcomes based on certain student characteristics in order to develop board policies or make recommendations for legislation to the legislature.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
