<u>Present law</u> allows DOTD to lease specialized maintenance equipment which will not be needed on a permanent basis for the shortest period required under the circumstances, in accordance with the public bid law, when the secretary determines that it is necessary or economically feasible.

<u>Present law</u>, in all other cases, requires the DOTD to own the fixed and mobile equipment necessary to appropriately maintain and operate the facilities under its jurisdiction.

<u>Present law</u> does not require the DOTD to accept equipment offered at the lowest price when purchasing equipment when such practice would result in the ownership or use of so many different types or brands that economic operation and maintenance of the equipment would be impracticable.

<u>Proposed law</u> changes <u>present law</u> to authorize DOTD to rent or lease fixed and mobile equipment necessary to appropriately maintain and operate its facilities.

<u>Proposed law</u> does not require DOTD to accept equipment offered at the lowest price when renting or leasing equipment.
