Abstract: Requires testing for elevated levels of lead in drinking water supplied by community water systems.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the office of public health of the La. Dept. of Health to perform a test, or assist in the performance of testing, for elevated levels of lead in drinking water, at least once per year, on all community water systems.

<u>Present law</u>, R.S. 40:31.33, establishes the safe drinking water fee. Provides for the amount of the fee and authorizes uses of fee amounts collected by the state. <u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and authorizes the use of such monies for the water testing required by proposed law.

(Adds R.S. 40:5.6.1 and 31.33(C)(4))

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The Committee Amendments Proposed by <u>House Committee on Health and Welfare</u> to the original bill:

1. Require that water testing be performed on all community water systems, rather than on all water supplies accessible by the public in state-owned, state-operated, or state-licensed facilities.
