**Abstract:** Provides relative to the authority of the secretary of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections to appoint special agents.

<u>Present law</u> authorizes the secretary of the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections to appoint special agents from permanent status employees or full-time employees who have attained the rank of sergeant or Probation and Parole Officer 1. The appointed special agents may carry weapons exposed or concealed while in the performance of their duties in the same manner as law enforcement officers.

<u>Present law</u> requires the secretary of the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections to adopt rules and regulations governing the qualifications and duties of special agents.

<u>Proposed law</u> amends <u>present law</u> to remove the requirement that a person be a permanent status or full-time employee in order to be appointed as a special agent.
