Abstract: Removes the legislative auditor's requirement to file copies of all audit reports with clerks of court.

Present law requires the legislative auditor to file copies of all audit reports with the governor, the attorney general, and the office investigated. Further requires the legislative auditor to file copies of all audit reports prepared by his office or accepted by his office in the clerk of court of the parish within which the office investigated is domiciled, except East Baton Rouge Parish and Orleans Parish. Requires clerks to make all reports available for public inspection for a period of time no less than one year starting on the first scheduled work day after expiration of three days from the time the report is filed in the office of the clerk of court. The reports are required to discuss all matters required by governmental auditing standards and recommendations.

Proposed law requires the legislative auditor requires the legislative auditor to make all copies of audit reports available on its website and removes the requirements that the auditor file copies with clerks of court.
