14	and adopt regulations regarding concealed handgun permits in accordance with the
15	Administrative Procedure Act. The permit shall contain a permit number, expiration
16	date, photograph, and the name, address, and date of birth of the permittee.

<u>Present law</u> provides that notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, the deputy secretary of public safety services of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections shall issue a concealed handgun permit to any La. resident who qualifies for a permit under the provisions of <u>present law</u> and may promulgate rules and adopt regulations regarding concealed handgun permits in accordance with the APA.

<u>Present law</u> provides that the permit shall contain a permit number, expiration date, photograph, and the name, address, and date of birth of the permittee.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that upon expiration of the concealed handgun permit, if the information required on the application has not changed, the permittee shall be allowed the option to indicate "No change." for the renewal of the concealed handgun permits authorized pursuant to <u>present law</u>.
