LEVEES: Prohibits the restriction of access to roads that are adjacent to levees

1	AN ACT
2	To enact R.S. 48:486, relative to roadways that are adjacent to levees; to prohibit a political
3	subdivision from restricting motor vehicle access on roads that are adjacent to
4	levees; to provide for exceptions; and to provide for related matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 48:486 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
7	§486. Motor vehicle access to roads adjacent to levees; exceptions
8	No political subdivision of the state shall in any manner close, place any
9	obstruction, or restrict motor vehicle access on any public road that runs parallel or
10	contiguous to any levee, except for any of the following reasons:
11	(1) To permit the performance of construction or maintenance operations on
12	the roadway.
13	(2) An emergency exists that requires the closure, obstruction, or restriction
14	of the roadway.

Abstract: Prohibits a political subdivision from restricting motor vehicle access on a road that is adjacent to a levee except when construction or maintenance is being performed on the roadway or if an emergency exists that requires the closing of the roadway.

<u>Proposed law</u> prohibits any political subdivision from closing, obstructing, or restricting motor vehicle access on any road parallel or contiguous to a levee, except when maintenance or construction is required on the roadway or an emergency exists that requires the closure, obstruction, or restriction.
