Claitor

<u>Present law</u> provides for membership on the LSBME. <u>Present law</u> provides for a member appointed from a list of names submitted by Tulane Medical School.

<u>Proposed law</u> repeals the appointment in <u>present law</u> and replaces the appointment with a non-physician member appointed from a list of names submitted by the chairmen of the senate and house committees on health and welfare.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the non-physician member provided for in <u>proposed law</u> shall serve only one term.

<u>Present law</u> provides relative to investigations by the LSBME. <u>Present law</u> provides for the procedure and causes for refusal to issue or revocation of any license or permit under its authority.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that no proceeding for disciplinary action may commence prior to receipt by the board of a complaint as provided for in <u>present law</u>.

Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Health and Welfare to the original bill

1. Replaces the physician member appointed to the board from a list of names submitted by Tulane Medical School with a non-physician member appointed from a list of names submitted by the chairmen of the senate and house committees on health and welfare and limits that appointment to a one- year term.
