16 or fraudulent claim"**17** AMENDMENT NO. 7**18** On page 3, delete lines 16 through 18 in their entirety**19** AMENDMENT NO. 8**20** On page 3, at the beginning of line 19, change "D." to "C."**21** AMENDMENT NO. 9**22** On page 3, between lines 23 and 24 insert the following:**23** "D. No person shall conspire to commit a violation of Subsections A, B, or
24 C of this Section."**25** AMENDMENT NO. 10**26** On page 3, delete lines 26 through 29 in their entirety and insert the following:**27** "F. No action pursuant to this Part shall be brought unless instituted within
28 six years from the date of the alleged violation, or within three years from the date
29 that the facts material to the cause of action are known or reasonably should have
30 been known by the attorney general or the state official charged with responsibility

1 to act in such circumstances, however even as to actions filed within three years from
2 the date of such knowledge, in all events such actions shall be instituted at the latest
3 within ten years from the date of the alleged violation."
