2 On page 1, delete line 17 and on page 2, delete lines 1 through 5, and insert

3 "(c)(i) After June 30, 2020, "child" means any person under the age of twenty-one, including an emancipated minor, who commits a delinquent act on or after July 1, 4 5 2020, and before the person attains eighteen years of age. After March 1, 2019, 6 "child" means any person under the age of twenty-one, including an emancipated minor, who commits a delinquent act on or after March 1, 2019, 8 when the act is not a crime of violence as defined in R.S. 14:2 and occurs before 9 the person obtains eighteen years of age, provided that the office of juvenile justice certifies on or before January 1, 2019, that there is adequate funding and 10 resources available to accommodate the projected increase in caseload." 11
