1 "F. The state Department of Education may assess a civil fine against 2 a city, parish, or other local public school board, equal to the average yearly 3 compensation for a public school teacher inclusive of salary and benefits, that employs a teacher or a substitute teacher who has been convicted of or pled 5 nolo contendere to any felony offense and whose application to teach was not 6 approved by the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education or for 7 whom criminal records were not requested by the school board. The department shall report any such instances of fee assessments to the House 8 9 Committee on Education and the Senate Committee on Education within 10 thirty days of such assessment. Civil fines collected pursuant to the 11 provisions of this Section shall be deposited immediately into the state 12 treasury. The State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education shall 13 promulgate rules in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act for 14 implementation of this Subsection."
