- 14 On page 1, at the beginning of line 10, change "22:1880(F)" to "22:1880.1"
- 15 <u>AMENDMENT NO. 6</u>

16 On page 1, line 13, after "facility" delete the remainder of the line and delete lines 14 17 through 19 in their entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following:

18 "shall <u>do all of the following</u>:

19 (1) Provide a written notice to an enrollee or insured at the first 20 registration contact with the enrollee or insured at the healthcare facility 21 regarding nonemergency services. A copy of the written notice shall be 22 signed by the enrollee or insured and be maintained by the healthcare facility. 23 The written notice shall regarding nonemergency services to a patient 24 whenever a healthcare facility provides a notice of privacy practices pursuant to 45 CFR. 164.520 to a patient for whom the healthcare facility has 25 26 knowledge that a contract with a health insurance issuer is effective or upon 27 the request of the patient. The written notice shall be signed by the patient 28 and disclose all of the following items:"

- 30 Delete pages 2 through 5 in their entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following:

| 33 | If a facility meets the definition of a provider-based entity, as defined         |
| 34 | by 42 CFR 413.65, and the facility is located off of the main hospital            |
| 35 | campus, the facility shall publicly post a notice to every patient disclosing the |
| 36 | following:  |

(1) That the enrollee or insured is receiving services in a hospital-based outpatient facility where the facility provides the use of the facility, medical, or technical equipment, supplies, staff, and services.

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(2) That depending on the enrollee's or insured's health insurance benefit plan and the actual services furnished by the facility, the patient may receive a facility charge billed separately from the physician that covers the fees for the use of the facility, medical, or technical equipment, supplies, staff, and services.

Section 2. R.S. 22:1880(C)(4) is hereby repealed in its entirety."
