5	H.(1) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, an offender
6	serving a life sentence for second degree murder (R.S. 14:30.1), shall be eligible for
7	parole consideration pursuant to the provisions of this Subsection if all of the
8	following conditions are met:
9	(1)(a) The offender committed the offense after July 2, 1973, and prior to
10	June 29, 1979.
11	(2)(b) The offender has served at least forty years of the sentence imposed.
12	(3) The committee on parole has granted parole with a unanimous vote of
13	those present.
14	(2) An offender who has met the requirements of Paragraph (1) of this
15	Subsection and is granted a hearing before the committee on parole shall be
16	released on parole only if the vote of the committee is unanimous in the
17	offender's favor."
