- (4)(a) Ordering an additional a medical or mental health opinion regarding a medical evaluation of the defendant or the abused person, or both, to be conducted by an independent court-appointed evaluator who qualifies as an expert in the field of domestic abuse. The evaluation shall be conducted by a person who has no family, financial, or prior medical or mental health relationship with the defendant or abused person, or their attorneys of record.
- (b) If the additional medical or mental health opinion medical evaluation is ordered for both the defendant and abused person, two separate evaluators shall be appointed.
- (c) After an additional <u>a</u> medical <u>or mental health</u> opinion medical evaluation has been completed and a report issued, the court may order counseling or other medical <u>or mental health</u> treatment as deemed appropriate."
