**HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 103**

A RESOLUTION

To designate Wednesday, April 18, 2018, as AARP Louisiana Caregiver Day at the state

capitol.

WHEREAS, Louisiana ranks thirty-seventh in the nation in long-term care; and

WHEREAS, an estimated six hundred sixty thousand family caregivers in Louisiana

provide care to adult relatives or friends, with the economic value of this care estimated to

be roughly six billion four hundred seventy million dollars annually; and

WHEREAS, almost ninety percent of Louisiana registered voters age forty-five and

older wish to remain in their homes and communities as they age; and

WHEREAS 28,000 older Louisianans are on waiting lists to receive assistance with

activities of daily living in their homes to avoid being put into nursing homes.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the

Legislature of Louisiana does hereby declare Wednesday, April 18, 2018, as AARP

Louisiana Caregiver Day at the state capitol.
