Present law requires standards based assessments in English language arts, mathematics, science, and social studies for public school students in a t least grades 3 through 11. Provides that such assessments be based on the state content standards and student achievement standards set with reference to test scores of students at the same grade level nationally. Proposed law requires the state department of Education to provide assessment results for each student by June 30th each school year; requires the local governing authority to disperse the results to students' teacher of record for the current and prior year. Provides for definition of scale score and raw score; requires longitudinal data for students' progress. Effective upon governor's signature.

## **EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION**

There is no anticipated impact to the Department of Education to provide assessment results to local school districts by June 30 each year. Local school districts may experience a reduction in costs as result of receiving assessment data earlier.
