RE1 NO IMPACT See Note Provides relative to payment of processing fee for certain garnishment proceedings

Purpose of the Bill: This bill provides that constables for justices of the peace are entitled to a 6% fee for collecting money for execution of a writ, without either seizure or sale. In addition, this bill provides that garnishment judgments will be paid to the sheriff, marshal, or constable for processing prior to being paid to the seizing creditor. Reasonable effort should be made to contact the seizing creditor for the current balance due before a garnishment is released or terminated.
