20 (24)(a) "Sex offense" means deferred adjudication, adjudication 21 withheld, or conviction for the perpetration or attempted perpetration of or conspiracy to commit human trafficking when prosecuted under the 22 23 provisions of R.S. 14:46.2(B)(2), R.S. 14:46.3 (trafficking of children for 24 sexual purposes), R.S. 14:89 (crime against nature), R.S. 14:89.1 (aggravated 25 crime against nature), R.S. 14:89.2(B)(3) (crime against nature by 26 solicitation), R.S. 14:80 (felony carnal knowledge of a juvenile), R.S. 14:81 27 (indecent behavior with juveniles), R.S.14:81.1 (pornography involving 28 juveniles), R.S. 14:81.2 (molestation of a juvenile or a person with a physical 29 or mental disability), R.S. 14:81.3 (computer-aided solicitation of a minor), 30 R.S. 14:81.4 (prohibited sexual conduct between an educator and student), 31 R.S. 14:82.1 (prostitution; persons under eighteen), R.S. 14:82.2(C)(4) and (5) (purchase of commercial sexual activity), R.S. 14:92(A)(7) (contributing 32 33 to the delinquency of juveniles), R.S. 14:93.5 (sexual battery of persons with 34 infirmities), R.S. 14:106(A)(5) (obscenity by solicitation of a person under 35 the age of seventeen), R.S. 14:283 (video voyeurism), R.S. 14:41 (rape), R.S. 36 14:42 (aggravated or first degree rape), R.S. 14:42.1 (forcible or second degree rape), R.S. 14:43 (simple or third degree rape), R.S. 14:43.1 (sexual 37 38 battery), R.S. 14:43.2 (second degree sexual battery), R.S. 14:43.3 (oral 39 sexual battery), R.S. 14:43.5 (intentional exposure to AIDS virus), or a 40 second or subsequent conviction of R.S. 14:283.1 (voyeurism), or a second or subsequent conviction of R.S. 14:89.3 (sexual abuse of an animal), 41 42 committed on or after June 18, 1992, or committed prior to June 18, 1992, if 43 the person, as a result of the offense, is under the custody of the Department 44 of Public Safety and Corrections on or after June 18, 1992. A conviction for 45 any offense provided in this definition includes a conviction for the offense 46 under the laws of another state, or military, territorial, foreign, tribal, or 47 federal law which is equivalent to an offense provided for in this Chapter, 48 unless the tribal court or foreign conviction was not obtained with sufficient 49 safeguards for fundamental fairness and due process for the accused as

- provided by the federal guidelines adopted pursuant to the Adam Walsh 1 2 Child Protection and Safety Act of 2006. 3
