#### HOUSE SUMMARY OF SENATE AMENDMENTS

### HB 624 2018 Regular Session Schexnayder

AGRICULTURE: Provides relative to the Commission of Weights and Measures

## **Synopsis of Senate Amendments**

- 1. Makes technical changes.
- 2. Adds mini-sacks to the requirement that sacks and barrels contain correct measurements at the time of delivery.

### Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

<u>Present law</u> provides for 10 members appointed by the commissioner of Agriculture and Forestry to the Commission of Weights and Measures. <u>Proposed law</u> authorizes the commissioner to appoint alternates from the same list of nominees in the same manner as each appointed member. Provides that each alternate attending a meeting has the same rights, powers, and privileges as the member, including voting.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the removal from the commission for any member who is no longer a resident of Louisiana, is no longer active in the organization or agency for which he was appointed to represent, or has three or more unexcused absences within a 12-month period of time as verified by the commissioner and the chairman of the commission.

<u>Proposed law</u> defines "basket" as a one and one-half bushel container used for measuring oysters for sale or purchase.

<u>Present law</u> requires that each sack of oysters contains one basket and each barrel contains two baskets. <u>Proposed law</u> requires that each mini-sack of oysters contains one-half bushel, each sack contains one and one-half bushels, and each barrel contains three bushels.

<u>Present law</u> requires that sacks and barrels contain correct measurements at the time of delivery to the consignee, buyer, or importer and at the time of delivery to any subsequent buyer. <u>Proposed law</u> extends the requirement to mini-sacks.
