Synopsis of Senate Amendments

1. Technical amendments only.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

<u>Present law</u> creates the Upper Audubon Security District in Orleans Parish as a political subdivision to aid in crime prevention and reduction by providing additional security for district residents.

Proposed law retains present law.

<u>Present law</u> authorizes the governing authority of the city of New Orleans to impose a parcel fee on behalf of the district, subject to voter approval. <u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u>.

<u>Present law</u> authorizes renewal of the fee, subject to voter approval, and requires the election for renewal of the fee to be held at the same time as a regularly scheduled election in the city of New Orleans.

Sec. 2 of Act No. 372 of the 2017 RS (effective Jan. 1, 2019) requires the election for renewal of the fee to be held only at the same time as the mayoral primary election for the city of New Orleans. <u>Proposed law</u> instead requires that the election for renewal be held at the same time as a regularly scheduled election in the city of New Orleans.

Effective January 2, 2019.
