Extra compensation for commissioned full-time levee district police 8 authorized 9 In addition to the compensation now paid to any levee district police 10 officer, every levee district police officer who is a full-time employee, is paid a 11 salary of not less than eight hundred dollars per month, has completed and passed a post-certified training program as provided in R.S. 40:2405, and has 12 13 completed or hereafter completes one year of service, may be paid extra 14 compensation by the levee district by which they are employed with district 15 funds in an amount up to but not greater than the amount authorized for 16 harbor police officers, fireboat operators, and bridge police officers by law.

<u>Proposed law</u>, relative to levee district police officers, authorizes the payment of extra compensation to officers who are full-time employees, are paid a salary of not less than \$800 per month, have completed and passed a post-certified training program as provided in R.S. 40:2405, and have completed or hereafter completes one year of service, by the district by which they are employed with district funds in an amount up to but not greater than the amount authorized for harbor police officers, fireboat operators, and bridge police officers by law.
