## HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 102

# PROPERTY: Requests the Louisiana State Law Institute to study provisions of law and make recommendations regarding modular homes

1	A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION
2	To urge and request the Louisiana State Law Institute to prepare proposed legislation
3	providing for the enactment of laws regarding modular homes and their classification
4	as movable or immovable property, developing the legal procedure for their
5	attachment to land, and securing them as loan collateral, and to report its findings to
6	the Louisiana Legislature no later than February 1, 2019.
7	WHEREAS, a modular home by definition is different and distinct from a
8	manufactured home and a mobile home; and
9	WHEREAS, modular homes, like mobile homes and manufactured homes, are sold
10	and located on property, and the property upon which a modular home is located may or may
11	not be owned by the owner of the modular home; and
12	WHEREAS, state laws have not been updated to provide for how and when modular
13	homes are classified as either titled movable property or immovable property, and
14	specifically, R.S. 9:1149.3 provides for the immobilization of manufactured homes and
15	mobile homes, but does not clearly address the immobilization of modular homes; and
16	WHEREAS, it is important to modular home purchasers, sellers, and lenders that the
17	laws clearly provide the process in which modular homes are secured by a lender's mortgage
18	or security interest in order to facilitate the financing of purchases.
19	THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby
20	urge and request the Louisiana State Law Institute to study provisions of law in order to
21	make recommendations regarding the classification of modular homes as movable or

immovable property, and to develop the legal procedure for their attachment to land and
 securing them as loan collateral.

- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby urge
  and request the Louisiana State Law Institute to include representatives of the office of
  motor vehicles, the Louisiana Clerks of Court Association, the Louisiana Manufactured
  Housing Association, the Louisiana Bankers Association, the Louisiana Association of
  Independent Land Title Agents, and the Louisiana Land Title Association, to the extent not
  already included in the study group.
  BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Louisiana State Law Institute shall submit
- 10 proposed legislation to the Louisiana Legislature no later than February 1, 2019.
- 11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the
- 12 director of the Louisiana State Law Institute.
