CHIROPRACTORS: Provides relative to the practice of chiropractic

## **Synopsis of Senate Amendments**

- 1. Provides for payment or reimbursement for any service performed by a licensed chiropractor in this state.
- 2. Provides that the reimbursement provision shall not affect any provision of the policy or contract regarding payment for services provided for by a noncontracted provider.
- 3. Makes mechanical traction and mechanical massage examples of mechanical devices.

HB 820 Engrossed

**Abstract:** Specifies the use of mechanical traction and mechanical message for the practice of chiropractic.

<u>Present law</u> defines the practice of chiropractic. <u>Present law</u> provides that the practice includes the use of mechanical devices.

<u>Proposed law</u> specifies the use of mechanical traction and mechanical massage to the practice of chiropractic.

<u>Present law</u> provides that whenever a policy or contract provides for payment or reimbursement for any service, and the service is performed by a licensed chiropractor in this state, the chiropractor is entitled to payment or reimbursement. <u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and adds that this provision shall not affect any provision of the policy or contract regarding payment for services provided by a non contracted provider
