SUMMARY OF HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO THE SENATE BILL

1. Adds railroad passenger stations to the list of establishments required to post information regarding the National Human Trafficking Resource Center hotline.

DIGEST OF THE SENATE BILL AS RETURNED TO THE SENATE

SB 166 Engrossed 2018 Regular Session

<u>Present law</u> requires information regarding the National Human Trafficking Resource Center Hotline to be posted in certain establishments.

<u>Present law</u> requires the notice to meet certain size, font, and language requirements set by the ATC commissioner.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and adds the requirement that airports, bus terminals or stations, and railroad passenger stations post information regarding the hotline in the same location where other employee notices required by law are posted.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the provisions of <u>proposed law</u> apply to public-use and private-use airports.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the provisions of <u>proposed law</u> apply to privately owned stations or terminals and those owned by the state or a local governing authority.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
