MTR VEHICLE/DRIVER LIC: Modifies requirements for obtaining a commercial driver's license when an applicant is employed in a specific military position

Synopsis of Senate Amendments

- 1. Makes technical changes.
- 2. Provides that only a Class "E" driver's license is required by an employee of the Dept. of Transportation and Development who is operating a commercial motor vehicle or bus in the course and scope of his employment during a gubernatorially declared state of emergency or disaster.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

<u>Present law</u> allows an applicant regularly employed within the last 90 days in a military position requiring operation of a commercial motor vehicle to waive the skills test required to obtain a commercial driver's license.

<u>Proposed law</u> increases the time period an applicant who is regularly employed in a military position requiring operation of a commercial motor vehicle to waive the skills test required to obtain a commercial driver's license <u>from</u> 90 days to 12 months.

<u>Proposed law</u> specifies that only a Class "E" driver's license is required for an employee of the Dept. of Transportation and Development who is operating a commercial motor vehicle or bus in the course and scope of his employment during a gubernatorially declared state of emergency or disaster.
