SUMMARY OF HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO THE SENATE BILL

1. Adds that in order to be considered prohibited contraband the firearm or other instrumentality must be possessed by a person who is prohibited from possessing the firearm or instrumentality pursuant to state or federal law.

<u>Present law</u> prohibits taking certain contraband into state-owned and administered hospitals.

<u>Proposed law</u> makes <u>present law</u> and <u>proposed law</u> applicable to all hospitals by removing "state-owned and administered".

<u>Present law</u> identifies one form of contraband prohibited in hospitals as narcotic or hypnotic drugs that create a hypnotic effect if taken internally. <u>Proposed law</u> modernizes this definition to include any controlled dangerous substance that has not been prescribed or recommended in accordance with the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Law.

<u>Present law</u> identifies one form of contraband prohibited in hospitals as any firearm or other instrumentality customarily considered a dangerous weapon.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that in order to be considered prohibited contraband the firearm or other instrumentality must be possessed by a person who is prohibited from possessing the firearm or instrumentality pursuant to state or federal law.
